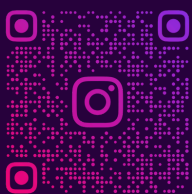
### HOVE INTERNS GRADUATES FROM UWI

## HIGH COURT DISMISSES MEDICAL NEGLIGENCE CLAIM AGAINST NCRHA

The Honourable Madame Justice Joan Charles dismissed Vern Khan's 2011 medical negligence claim against the NCRHA, finding treatment met medical standards and delays were not negligent. Non-compliance by Mr. Khan contributed to his condition. Judgment and \$14,000 in costs awarded to the NCRHA, represented by Farai Hove Masaisai of Hove and Associates.
